WHY RECYCLE

Recycling saves energy and natural resources, creates jobs and saves landfill space. Items you recycle are transported to companies that process the material and use or sell the fiber for reuse. Help to preserve the quality of our environment. Reduce the amount of garbage you throw away, reuse the material or donate it to charity and participate in the recycling programs offered.

RECYCLING TIPS

- Don't fall for the myth that recyclable materials just end up in the landfill. Recycling is a business and recycling companies have to pay for disposal just like you. Many recycling companies offer payment based on the resale rate for items you recycle. It doesn't make business sense for them to pay you for recyclable goods and then pay a landfill to dispose of them.
- Do call ahead to make sure your item is recyclable. Do NOT leave garbage or non-accepted items at recycling centers*.
- Don't throw any hazardous wastes in the trash. Hazardous waste includes: gasoline, aerosols, paint, cleaning agents, stain, motor oil and anything else containing chemicals that should not end up in landfills*.
- Don't throw away technological items like cell phones, computers, ink cartridges or batteries. All these items are recyclable*.
